# Kitchen Renos

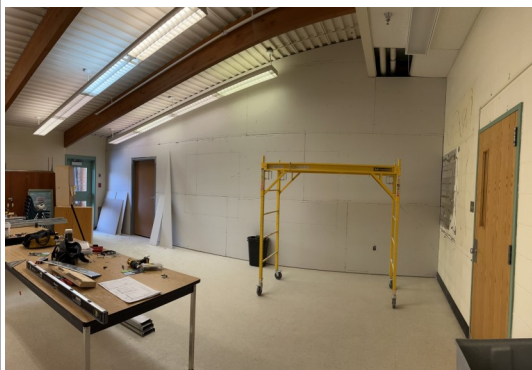
