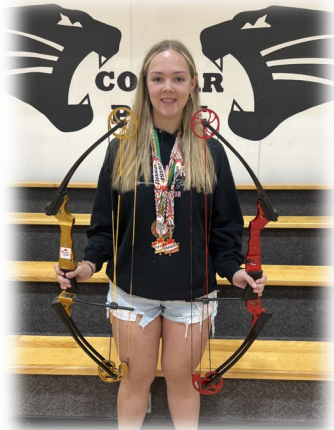

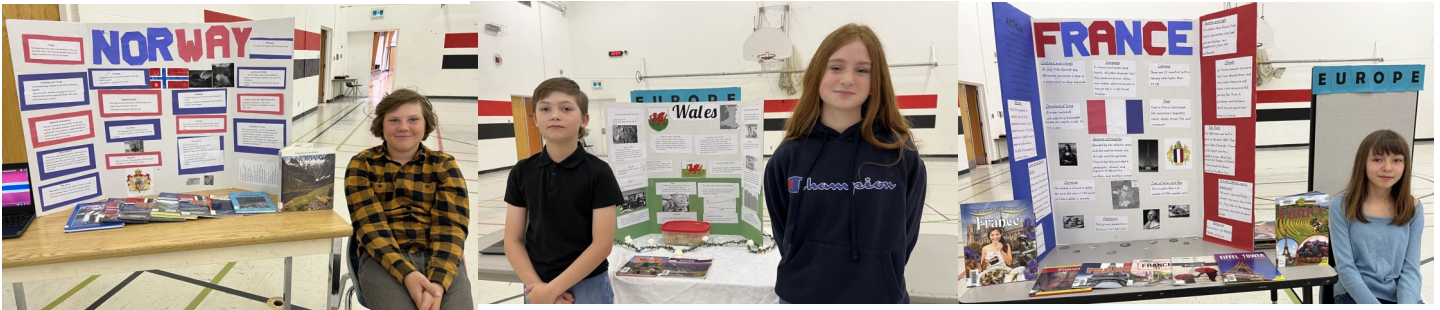

International Bazaar

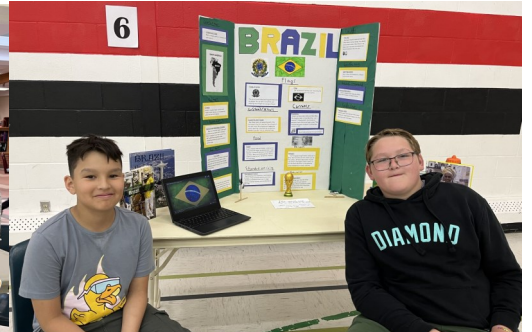
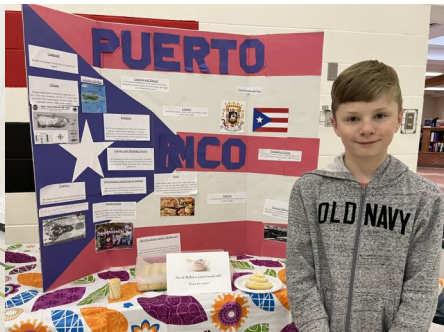

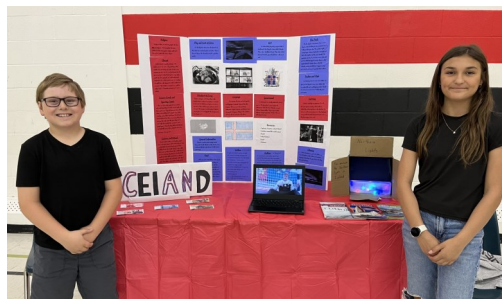
