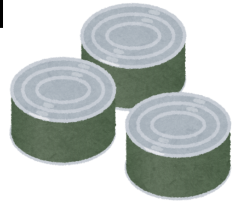


Health: Grade 9's, baking muffins

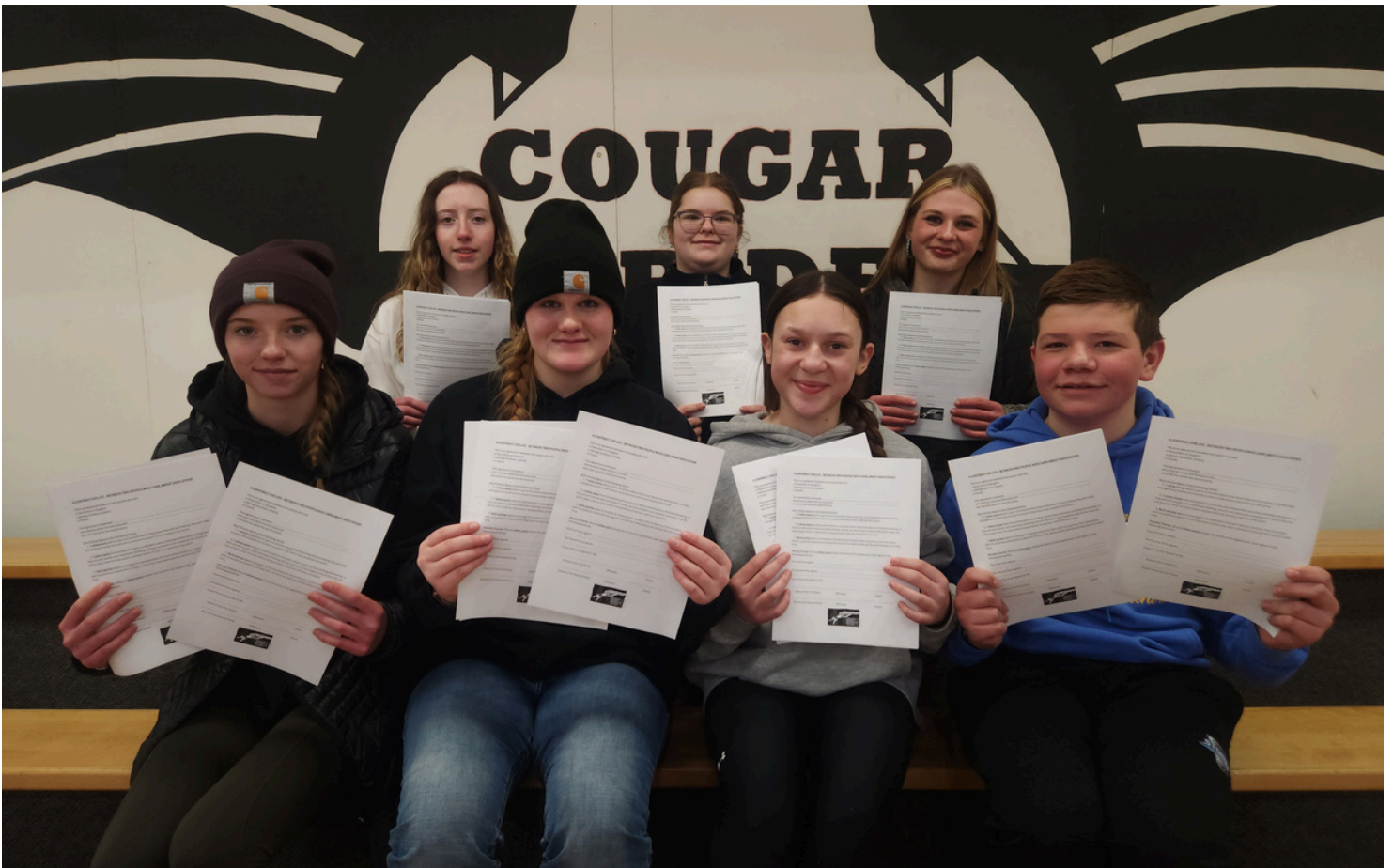

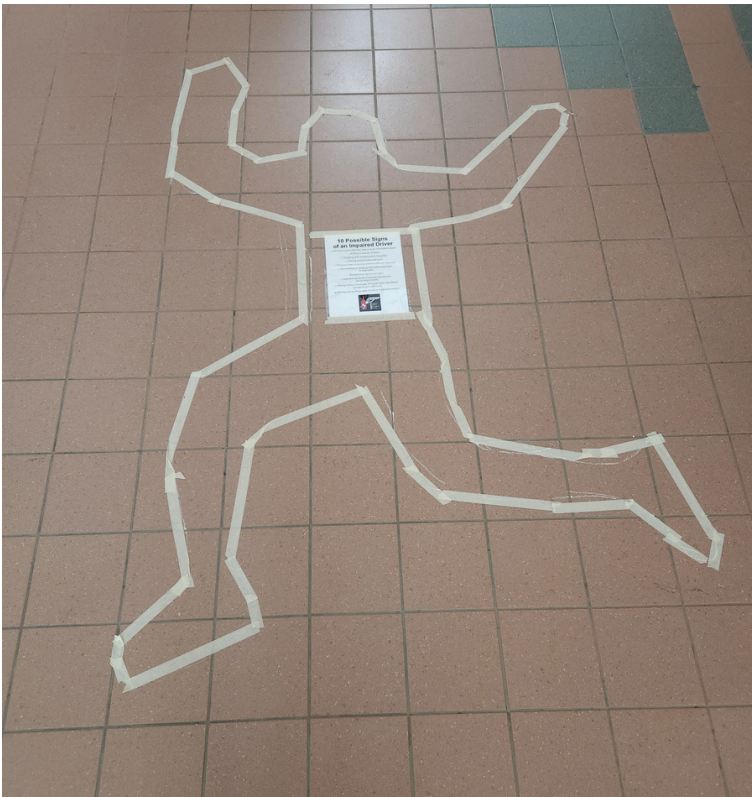

Grade 8's Ice Fishing Mar. 13 at Crystal Lake

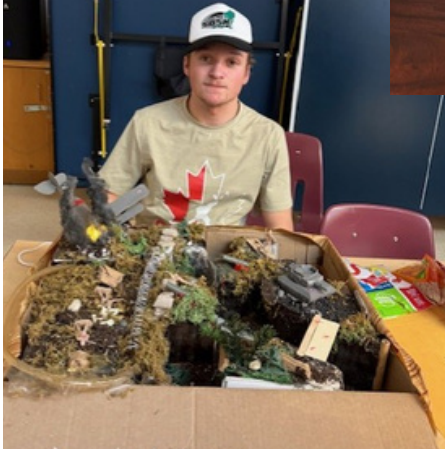

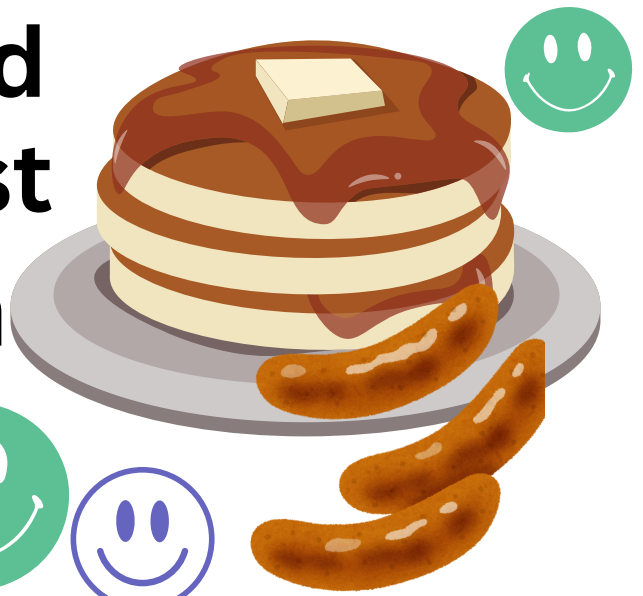
